Chairman Larsen called the meeting to order at 10:03 AM.

-Cemetery Improvements

Chairman Larsen had a list of proposed improvements to the Old Section of the Village Cemetery and would like to make a request to the DDA to fund the improvements.

Moved by Karjalainen, seconded by Carlson, to go forward with the improvements and get estimates on the following projects: Paint the Village Cemetery sign, install solar spotlights on Village Cemetery sign, landscape around the sign, install gated entry off M-18 (walkway), install a sidewalk to gated entry and around sign from existing sidewalk, install a contemplation area, place limestone on path sections, install new fence on M-18 front of cemetery. All in favor. Hearing no objections, the motion carried.

-Seal coating of driveway in New Section of the Village Cemetery

Moved by Karjalainen, seconded by Carlson, to get estimates to seal the portion of the driveway from George Street to the Chapel. All in favor. Hearing no objections, the motion carried.

-Cemetery mapping

Manager Lowe to contact Kirtland Community College regarding computer drawings of the cemetery map.

Moved by Carlson, seconded by Karjalainen, to allow the Village Manager to authorize seal coating in the New Cemetery if under \$1,000. All in favor. Hearing no objections, the motion carried.
