

VILLAGE OF ROSCOMMON  
Cemetery Board of Trustees Meeting  
October 28, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 PM and the Pledge of Allegiance recited. Members present were June Karjalainen, Lisa Gillett and Mike Butler.

Moved by Karjalainen, seconded by Gillett, to appoint Mike Butler as Chair of the Board. All in favor. None opposed.

Old Business:

Monument Repair – tabled for the next meeting.

Burial space for cremations: Discussed the circular sign with pie shaped sections for burying the urns. The sections would be about 3' X 6' with the headstones near the outside edge. Also, considered columbariums which are expensive. Need to check into legality, depth of burials, divider between sections, survey of land and regulations.

New Business:

Discussed St. Helen Monument's request to place a marker with Fern Ball's ashes in it on a grave that has a marker shared with the grave next to it. It is on graves 3 & 4, Lot 8. The Cemetery Ordinance provides for only one marker per grave.

Moved by Gillett, to follow the ordinance and deny the request. Karjalainen seconded the motion. All in favor, the motion passed.

Cemetery Expansion: Butler proposed two possible locations to expand. State land on South Street and a section of the M-18 property off Southline. Need to look into what expense each property would entail such as clearing, surveying and providing water/well and electrical to site.

Butler will talk to Steve Anderson from the State, Walsh's and check into well and power.

The next meeting will be at 3:00 PM on Thursday, January 13, 2011.

Moved by Gillett to adjourn at 3:45PM. Seconded by Karjalainen. Hearing no objections, the meeting adjourned.
