

VILLAGE OF ROSCOMMON  
ORDINANCE 50

PLANNING COMMISSION

The Village of Roscommon does hereby ordain:

1. There is hereby established a Planning Commission to be known as the Roscommon Village Planning and Zoning Commission pursuant to M.C.L.A. 125.31 to 125.45, Public Act 285 of 1931, as amended.
2. The Roscommon Village Planning and Zoning Commission shall have all powers and duties which can be conferred upon said Commission by the Roscommon Village Council pursuant to M.C.L.A. 125.31 to M.C.L.A. 125.45, as amended, or by other provisions of the law and each and all of the powers are hereby conferred and incorporated as fully as though set out verbatim herein.
3. (a) The Commission shall consist of five (5) members appointed by the Roscommon Village President, subject to approval by majority vote of the Roscommon Village Council. The terms shall be for three (3) years or until a successor takes office except that the respective terms of two (2) of the members first appointed shall be for one (1) year and two (2) for two years.  
  
(b) In addition to the five (5) appointed members, there shall be one ex-officio member and serve during their term of office:
  1. The Village President OR
  2. An administrative official of the Village of Roscommon OR
  3. One member of the Village Council selected by its members  
(c) The basis for representative membership of the Commission shall be representatives of the entire geography of the local unit of government to the extent possible.  
  
(d) Vacancies shall be filled by the Village President subject to approval of the Village Council.

4. The Village Council may remove any member of the Commission for non-performance of duties or misconduct pursuant to reasonable notice in writing and after a public hearing.
- 5a. No ex-officio member shall be entitled to compensation for services upon the Commission.
- 5b. All appointed members of the Commission may be compensated at a rate to be determined by the legislative body.
6. The Commission shall elect its chairperson from among the appointed members and create and fill such other of its offices as it may determine. The term of chairperson shall be one (1) year, with eligibility for re-election. The Commission shall hold at least one (1) regular meeting in each month. It shall adopt rules for transaction of business and shall keep a record of its resolutions, transactions, findings and determinations which record shall be a public record.
7. Ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the above are hereby repealed. Sections of this ordinance shall be determined severable and should any section or provision of this ordinance be declared by the courts to be invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not effect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.
8. This Act shall take effect August 1, 1995

Passed by the Village Council of the Village of Roscommon on the July 20, 1995, at its special meeting with six members in attendance, six voting aye and none voting nay.
