

PROMOTION USING VILLAGE PROPERTY

The purpose of this policy is to identify and regulate the use of Village owned and controlled property for the purpose of promoting events, sales or viewpoints by individuals, groups or organizations other than the Village government.

Village owned and controlled property includes Village owned buildings, Wallace Park, rights-of-way, cemetery, real estate, light poles and appurtenances, fences, vehicles, equipment and Public Education Access Channel.

Sales are the marketing of any service, item or property.

An event is any scheduled or spontaneous occurrence for which promotion is sought.

A viewpoint is any belief or understanding held by an individual or group of individuals that they wish to publicly express.

The use of Village owned and controlled property for promoting events, sales or viewpoints shall be permitted only as prescribed in this policy.

The Village of Roscommon does not allow the placement or attachment of any material to its Village Hall, utility buildings and structures, rights-of-way, cemetery, real estate, light poles and appurtenances, fences, vehicles or equipment for promotion of events, sales or viewpoints.

Material may be placed in the information literature rack in the lobby of Village Hall. The Village reserves the right to restrict placement, limit the size and quantity of the material and regulate the duration of placement.

The Public Education Government Access channel may be utilized to promote non-profit events pursuant to the conditions of the PEG Programming Certification and Indemnification Agreement executed between the Cable Operator and the Village of Roscommon. The Village of Roscommon reserves the right to edit submitted material and limit the duration of airing the material. The Village makes no claim as to the quality or consistency of the broadcast signal or transmission.

Wallace Park may be utilized for the purpose of conducting and promoting non-profit events only. The Village reserves the right to limit the time frame of the event. All such events need pre-approval of the Village.
